

# Registering for an existing External CPD Event

(Continuous Professional Development)

#### What are External CPD Events


External CPD Events are organised by an ESO, Community of Practice or Individuals to reinforce and extend an advocate's knowledge and skill sets. The events are educational in nature and relevant to Wellbeing and/or Compensation Advocacy. Attendance at these events may attract CPD Points.

## How do I find an External CPD Event

The area on the Home Page where the list of CPD Upcoming Events is located on the right-side midway down the page:



If you click on the Read More button, the following screen opens:

The screen provides you with details of the CPD Upcoming Event. This allows you to determine if you would like to attend.

# How to register for the External CPD Event

The registration process records an Advocate's intent to attend the Event.

Note: CPD points are only allocated after the Event Convenor has confirmed your attendance after the event.

#### Step One: Log into the ATDP Portal


#### Step Three: CPD Workspace


